DIRECTIONS
From the East: Exit I-70 in Ohio at exit # 202 and follow SR 800 North about 9 miles. **(From the West:** Exit I-70 in Ohio at exit # 198, Turn Left/North on CR 114, then turn Right/East on Old National 40A. At the stop sign, turn Left/North on SR 800. Follow SR 800 for 6 miles.) Turn Right/East onto 4H Camp Rd at the sign for about 1 mile. Following the 4-H signs, Bear Left/North onto Briar Wood Dr; Bear Right/East up the hill onto Briar Hill Rd for about 1/2 mile, then bear Left at the next intersection for another 1/2 mile on the gravel road. Bear Right onto 4H Club Rd and arrive at the camp. Follow signs to registration.
